Available in limited quantity in late spring, we offer starter nuclei for top bar hives in 3-frame sets only - \$100.00
 Top Bar starter nucs are established mini families with transferable honeycomb, bees, brood, food stores and a freshly mated Queenbee of the season.

As a standard, we utilize 19 inch long wooden top bars that are 1/2 inch thick with a recycled Pierco starter strip. This starter strip (holding the honeycomb) can be unscrewed and screwed onto personally sized top bars. By using 19 inch long top bars that are 1/2-inch thick, one is better able to interchange their top bars with standard Langstroth users.

Transport your nuc in a reusable 5-frame waxed cardboard nuc box (with air vents and plug) for \$10.00.
